### Manitoba Summer Fair Approaches!

Other returning attractions include the Horse Shows, great midway rides, a tradeshow, the Towne Square and Multicultural Marketplace, Kidzone and a Battle of the Bands Contest on the outdoor entertainment stage. New this year is the Carnival Club, the hottest night club in town featuring a Mardi Gras party on Friday and Saturday nights, with prizes given away every hour.

Entertainment this year includes the Flying Fools' High Dive Act, Little Ray's Reptile Zoo, Las Vegas Hypnotist Terry Stokes, Doodles the Clown and the Puppet Tamer.

Advance Pay-One-Price tickets are available till 4PM on June 9 at both Sobey's locations and the Shoppers Mall. Free child tickets (ages 6 – 12) are available for download from the fair's website prior to the opening of the fair, and children under 6 can always enjoy the fair for free.
