## FEES

CHEQUES for stalls and entry fees are to be made payable to the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba

VISA OR MASTERCARD PAYMENT IS ACCEPTED

### STABLING

Horse Stalls: \$73.50 (incl. GST & enviro fee) per stall per weekend  
Tack Stalls: \$63.00 (incl. GST)

Stalls are mandatory for all competitors.

All stalls must be ordered and paid for prior to May 30<sup>th</sup>.

Do not choose your own stalls. Stalls are assigned and any changes must be confirmed with the show secretary.

Those wishing to be stabled together should so request with their stall reservation. Stall bookings are to be made with the Show Secretary. Please make reservation in the name of the person or stable responsible for paying show fees. Advise the show secretary prior to show date if you need to cancel your reservation. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of your fees.

Prepaid stalls will be assigned as per your request. Late reservations will be available on a first come basis depending on the time of reservation.

### ENTRY FEES

Novice Youth	\$ 6.00 per class	or	\$25.00 per horse per show

Novice Amateur	\$ 6.00 per class	or	\$30.00 per horse per show

### OTHER FEES

Office charge	\$15.00 per horse per show
Exhibitor Passes:	\$19.95 (incl. GST) per person per weekend or \$7.00 day pass
Camping Permit:	\$21.00 (incl. GST) per night
AQHA Processing Fee	\$4.00 per horse per show

**Camping permits** must be booked with the Show Secretary when booking your stalls. All campers require a permit. Electrical plug-in spaces are limited and are available on a first come basis. Electrical service is 115 volt only – NO AIR CONDITIONERS.

NOTE: Any vehicles not parked in the designated areas or without camping permits, will be towed away at the owner's expense.

**Exhibitor passes** are to be ordered with stall reservations. Your name will be listed at the gate for admission to grounds. If not prearranged, please pay at gate.

Exhibitors are asked to use the Exhibitor's Entrance on 13<sup>th</sup> Street and Brandon Avenue. After horses and equipment have been unloaded, vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area north-east of the barn unless you have living quarters and have a camping area pre-booked.

The Quarter Horse Office will be open on Thursday at 5:00 p.m. Report to the office for entry forms, camping permits, exhibitor and vehicle passes.

## **SHOW RULES**

1. Rules shall apply in all classes according to the current Official Handbook of A.Q.H.A.
2. All shows are post entry.
3. Each show may be entered on a daily basis or may be entered for the entire circuit. If entries are made for the entire circuit and you wish to change entries on subsequent days of the circuit, do so at the show office prior to the start of the class. It is preferred that you enter for the entire circuit – it is easier to remove you from the class than to add.
4. A \$35.00 fee will be charged on all cheques not honoured. Failure to clear the debt promptly may result in suspension from AQHA.
5. Show management reserves the right to alter the program and class schedule. Changes will be announced.
6. Original or exact copy of registration papers must be presented with all entries.
7. All exhibitors must present current AQHA membership cards at the time of entry. Temporary memberships may be purchased from the Show Secretary prior to the start of show.
8. AQHA Rules on Drug Testing and Therapeutic Medication Reports will be adhered to.
9. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times, and will not be allowed in any area of the complex, other than the barns.
10. Exhibitor numbers will be assigned by the show secretary on Thursday of show weekend.

## **CIRCUIT AWARDS**

**Must participate in all 4 shows to be eligible to win**

**HALTER:** Open halter classes – Stallions, Mares, Geldings – based on the highest aggregate points awarded over the weekend. One award for each division.

**ALL AROUND OPEN HORSE (JUNIOR OR SENIOR):** Total points earned in performance classes.

**NOVICE YOUTH PERFORMANCE:** Total points earned in novice youth performance and showmanship classes.

**YOUTH (13 & UNDER):** Total points earned in youth halter, performance and showmanship.

**YOUTH (14 – 18 YEARS):** Total points earned in youth halter, performance and showmanship.

**GRASSROOTS YOUTH (18 & UNDER):** Total points earned in grass roots performance and showmanship.

**NOVICE AMATEUR:** Total points earned in novice amateur performance and showmanship.

**AMATEUR:** Total points earned in amateur halter, performance and showmanship classes.

**SELECT AMATEUR:** Total points earned in select performance and showmanship. Special AQHA award.

Daily points will be accumulated for Sunday final payout.  
Lowest points are winners.
