HORSE SHOW RULES

**** ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY PROPER LIABILITY INSURANCE WHILE PARTICIPATING AT PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION of MANITOBA EVENTS ** (proof may be required)**

1. All Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba General Rules and Regulations as well as the 2010 EC Rule Book (which can be downloaded) apply to this show. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors and visitors to familiarize themselves with these rules. All EC recognized protests will follow the EC Rule Book.

2. MEMBERSHIP: All owners, riders/drivers trainers and agents must be E.C./A.S.H.A. individual competitor members in good standing to show at E.C. Associate membership and breed association membership is required for affiliated breed classes. **Membership numbers MUST be included on the entry form.** If you are not a member, temporary membership at \$30.00 must be purchased at time of making entry with show secretary. Exception: See E.C. General Rules Chapter 2, pg. 1.

ENTRIES: An entry is valid only when the Summer Fair receives a completed Entry Form including payment in full by either cheque or credit card, not later than the entry closing date.

3. AMATEUR CARDS - are required by Competitors in the Amateur classes:

PROOF OF AMATEUR STATUS AND 2010 MEMBERSHIPS FOR BOTH RIDER & OWNER
MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS (Photocopies acceptable)
See article A 902
***** THIS IS MANDATORY!!! *****

4. All entries must be submitted on the entry form provided and all information necessary for the class must be legible. Failure to comply will render the entry null and void. No changes or substitutions are allowed after the submission of entries.

5. All animals in competition must be entered in the name of the bona-fide owner, or their authorized agents, except for those entered in Equitation classes. Affidavits of ownership may be requested.
6. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba unconditionally reserves the right to accept or reject any entry and return the entry fee without being liable for compensation. The decision of the Horse Show Committee is final.
7. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba reserves, unconditionally, the right to inspect or verify any entry.
8. Prize money will be paid to the person whose name appears on the entry form as the owner **unless otherwise specified on entry form**. Juniors must have their parent or guardian signature on the entry form and waiver forms must be filled out and signed.
9. Should a prize be found to have been awarded in error on the part of the judges, clerks or director in charge, or false evidence, or by misrepresentation or violation of any of the rules, the money will be withheld or if paid in error, must be returned.
10. Prize cheques will be mailed and must be cashed within four months of date of issue. All cheques not cashed within this period will be forfeited.
11. Classes specifying height of horse or pony require that the exhibitor obtain a certificate before entering the ring. Exhibitors will be advised as to location and time by notices in the building.
12. Cross entering is permitted in Hunter, Jumper and Hack Divisions as allowed by E.C. rules.
13. **Juniors may not ride or handle stallions on the grounds.**
14. A class may be declared off at the discretion of the Horse Show Committee if insufficient entries are received. In all classes where the number of entries are less than the number of premiums offered, it shall be the duty of the Judge to decide what premiums shall be awarded, fully taking into consideration the quality of the competition and no animal deemed unworthy by the Judge shall be awarded a premium. Classes must have 4 entries in order to show. The Horse Show Committee may affect transfers of animals between classes to comply with this regulation.
15. **CANCELLATION: CLASS ENTRY FEES ONLY will be refunded upon receipt of certification of disability from a qualified Veterinarian (stall fees will not be refunded). NO REFUND will be made on cancellations received after the holding of the first class in which the horse is entered.**
16. **SCRATCHES:** Scratches should be made one-half hour prior to the first horse or pony entering the ring for that performance. We would appreciate your co-operation in this regard to enable us to keep the show moving and running smoothly
17. ALL exhibitors will receive a set of numbers for each horse entered. Equitation riders WILL NOT need an additional set of numbers.
18. **DRESS FOR EXHIBITORS AND ATTENDANTS:** Suit or habit (dress-shirt, tie, & hat). Exhibitors and attendants are not allowed in the ring unless appropriately attired.
19. **HELMETS (HARD HATS):** Amended 2006: Ref G102.1 At all EC-sanctioned competitions, all competitors, including foreign competitors, in EC National classes must wear ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened at all times while mounted on the competition grounds. **2006 Rule G102.2 "Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened."**
20. Behaviour of exhibitors and associates must be above reproach at all times. Failure to comply may result in ejection from the buildings, forfeiture of entry fees and suspension of exhibiting privileges.
21. All horses are subject to drug testing and all owners agree that by making their entry, they will allow their horses to be tested. The Testing Program will be carried out by the E.C. Manitoba Provincial Drug Committee. Chapter 10 (General Regs), entitled "Medication Control" in the 2010 Rule Book will govern, and special attention should be given by all exhibitors to reading this Chapter carefully. It will be enforced, including the inspection of personal property. Positive tests will result in prizes being forfeited and a denial of entry to all future Manitoba Summer Fair Hunter/Jumper competitions. Exhibitors will be assessed a fee of **\$7.00** per horse/pony entered, which will be forwarded to the Provincial office to provide funds for research, inspection and enforcement regarding use of medication and drugs.

22. All exhibits shall be under the control and direction of the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba but solely at the risk of the exhibitor. The Provincial Exhibition will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft to any exhibit, irrespective of the cause of such damage, injury, loss or theft, whether such is caused by negligence or not. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, occasioned by or arising from any article/animal exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the Provincial Exhibition against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.
23. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba is not by law responsible to any one exhibitor or spectator, for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to a person or animal or things on the premises of the show.
24. The building will be available for general occupancy on the Thursday.
25. No animal suffering disease or unsoundness will be permitted into the building. Should sickness develop after admittance, the animal will be subject to immediate removal on the authority of the official veterinarian.
26. No exhibitor is permitted to select his/her stabling and will occupy that space designated for him/her. In the absence of such designation, advice shall be sought from the Horse Show Committee. This rule will be strictly enforced.
27. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own stall bedding. Bedding and feed will be available for sale on the grounds [supplies will be limited].
28. Stalls are to be cleaned, into the designated areas, prior to 8:00 a.m. Aisles and passages will be kept clean and clear at all times.
29. Livestock vehicles will park in assigned areas. Parking in any restricted area is strictly prohibited. Once vehicles have been unloaded they are to be moved to the assigned area. This rule will be strictly enforced and offenders will have their vehicles towed away at the owner's expense.
30. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to change or amend show scheduling up to one (1) hour prior to the designated class.
31. The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error.
32. The decision of the judges shall be final. Protests must be made out to the Hunter/Jumper Summer Fair Horse Show Committee in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 cash or certified cheque as per EC rules where applicable for a Horse Show. Such protests must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal and must be delivered to the Horse Show Committee within 48 (forty-eight) hours after the occasion for such protest.
33. Any exhibitor not complying with these Rules may, at the discretion of the Horse Show Committee, forfeit all or any portion of his/her prize money.
34. There will be Veterinary and Ferrier Service on call for this event.

EQUINE CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

The E.C., the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

The E.C. is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.

- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING ENTRIES TO E.C.

RECOGNIZED MEMBER SHOWS

FOR 2010 E.C. MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED OF ALL COMPETITORS, TRAINERS, OWNERS, LEASEES & AGENTS EXCEPT:

A) Members of National Breed Organizations which are affiliated with the Equine Canada have the right to show in their Breed Division Classes at all Recognized E.C. shows, where E.C. membership is a requirement, without becoming an Individual Competitor Member of the E.C. However, they require a temporary sport license.

B) Reg A208, Exhibitors who are NOT members of the E.C. will be permitted to exhibit at any recognized show/event in any calendar year with the purchase of a TEMPORARY COMPETITORS' SPORT LICENSE and payment of a thirty (\$30.00) fee for that specific show/ event to be collected by the Show Secretary and forwarded to the E.C. National Office along with a copy of the Temporary Membership form. Exhibitors who have not reached their tenth (10th) birthday as of January 1st of the current year entering walk-trot, lead-line, pet-pony, short stirrup classes only are exempt from E.C. membership. Passports and memberships of the owner of ponies or horses in such classes are not required. This rule also applies to drivers under 10 years of age who compete in pet-pony and pleasure driving ponies where the driver is restricted to under 10.

C) Entries limited to classes under National and Canadian Cutting Horse Rules.

D) Entries limited to Canadian Girls' Barrel Racing Events under C.G.R.A. Rules.

E) Exhibitors and equitation riders from other countries who are bona fide members of their own National Equestrian Federations which are members of the Federation Equestre Internationale.

EXCEPTION - E.C. Medal.

Entries under A), B), C), D), and E) above will not count towards E.C. Provincial Championship Awards. Also, such equitation riders may not enter E.C. Medal Classes.

- C) Is not currently on CET Jumping Team short list.
