

without compensation. If a player has chips totaling 50% of more of the new chip value the chips will be exchanged for a new chip.

- Play will continue until all but one player is eliminated. The order of finish shall be the order of elimination from last to first. The last remaining player shall be declared the winner.
- If multiple players are eliminated on the same hand, the player starting the hand with the larger amount of chips finishes in the higher place for the prize money. In the event that players started the hand with the same amount of chips, they will be declared tied and will share equally in the prize money.
- If a player leaves the table, his hand will post and fold unless he returns by the time it is his turn to act. His blind will be posted and the hand will be folded when there is action. If a player is absent for more than 10 minutes they will be eliminated from the tournament and their chips removed from play.
- The tournament will be held in English only.
- Blinds Schedule (to increase every 20 minutes)
