M.A.A.S. Quilt Competition Rules & Regulations

- Competition is open to all quilt exhibitors who have not won first prize in the Agricultural Societies' Provincial Quilt Competition in the past three years.
- The judging criteria used for judging is included in the "Judging Standards" book.
- Entry can be hand quilted or machine quilted. No commercial quilting will be allowed. **The entry must be quilted by the person submitting the quilt.**
- Quilts must have an appropriate title.
- Quilts must be at least 152cm x 178cm (60" x 70") to be considered for the competition.
- A Score Sheet will be distributed to all societies which must be used to judge the quilts. Any quilt not scoring 70 or more points will not qualify for the district or final competition.
- Each society may select three (3) quilts at their fair to participate in the district competition. Up to four (4) quilts will be chosen at the district competition to go to the provincial competition, either machine or hand quilted.
- Exhibitors may enter more than one quilt in this competition. However, they may only have one quilt advance to the provincial finals.
- Any quilt may be entered in competition at as many fairs as the exhibitor wishes. However, it may only represent the society where it was first entered in the provincial competition and won. The exhibitor must advise societies at the time of entry if the quilt is a winner at a previous fair.
- If an exhibitor does not wish to participate in the provincial competition, the runner-up quilt will be selected to represent the society in the district competition.
- At the end of the competition, the quilts will be returned to the quilters.
- Pictures of the winning quilts and exhibitors are to be kept each year and placed in a traveling album.
- At the district level prize monies of \$20.00 will be awarded for the two top quilts in each category. At the finals \$1,200.00 will be awarded in the hand quilting category (1st prize \$750 & 2nd prize \$450) and \$800.00 in the machine quilting category (1st prize \$500 & 2nd prize \$300).
- **Pre-stamped and Cut Quilt kits are NOT allowed to enter, however 'Block-of-the-Month' quilts are eligible for the competition.**
- Quilt is to be available for display at the M.A.A.S. conference until after Saturday night banquet - approximately 10:30 p.m.
- **Quilt owners are responsible for insuring their own quilts. The sponsors, societies, and M.A.A.S. will not be liable for damage or loss.**
