1. All Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba General Rules and Regulations as well as the 2010 EC Rule Book (which can be downloaded) apply to this show. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors and visitors to familiarize themselves with these rules. All EC recognized protests will follow the EC Rule Book.

2. **MEMBERSHIP:** All Canadian entries are required to hold both an EC passport and a valid EC horse license to compete, or if owned by Temporary Sport License holder, a temporary horse registration form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit. (See A404) Associate membership and breed association membership is required for affiliated breed classes. **Membership numbers MUST be included on the entry form.** If you are not a member, temporary membership at \$30.00 must be purchased at time of making entry with show secretary. Exception: See E.C. General Rules Chapter 2, pg. 1.

3. **ENTRIES:** An entry is valid only when the RMWF receives a completed Entry Form including payment in full by either cheque or credit card, not later than the entry closing date.

**AMATEUR CARDS** - see Article A 902 Amateur cards are required by Competitors in the following classes:

Division - Junior / Amateur / Non Pro Hunter'

Division - Pre Child / Adult Ami Hunter

**NON - PRO**

DEFINITION:-A Non-Professional Rider is defined as a competitor who: a) does not receive remuneration for riding/showing other people's horses, Exception: a non-professional rider may ride a horse which he/she has leased under a EC/FEI registered lease; b) is not a NCCP fully certified Level 3 or higher coach; and, c) is not currently on C.E.T. Jumping Team short list.

**JUNIORS AND BONIFIED AMATEURS** entering in the Miscellaneous Amateur/Non Pro division will still qualify for E.C. zone awards.

**PROOF OF AMATEUR STATUS AND 2010 MEMBERSHIPS FOR BOTH RIDER & OWNER MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS (Photocopies acceptable)**

4. All animals in competition must be entered in the name of the bona-fide owner, or their authorized agents, except for those entered in Equitation classes. Affidavits of ownership may be requested.

**5. Prize money:** will be paid to the person whose name appears on the entry form as the owner **unless otherwise specified on the entry form.** Juniors must have their parent or guardian signature on the entry form and waiver forms must be filled out and signed. A list of entries will be posted prior to each class where add backs are involved. (Article A702)

6. Juniors may not ride, drive, show on the line or handle stallions on the grounds.

7. **DUE TO TIME SCHEDULING HORS CONCOURS** entries **WILL NOT** be accepted

8. **NUMBER FEE:** ALL exhibitors will receive a set of numbers for each horse entered at a cost of \$5.00 per set.

Equitation riders **WILL NOT** need an additional set of numbers.

**Those exhibitors using their own numbers should give notice on the entry form in the space provided, otherwise number fees will be charged on the account.**

**\*\*\*Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring. (See Article A814)\*\*\***

9. **Measurement of Ponies:** Classes specifying height of horse or pony require that the exhibitor obtain a certificate before entering the ring. Exhibitors must present there ponies to be **measured on Saturday, March 27, 2010 at 3:00pm in the hallway in front of the livestock office.**

10. A class may be declared cancelled at the discretion of the Committee if insufficient entries are received. In all classes where the number of entries are less than the number of premiums offered, it shall be the duty of the Judge to decide what premiums shall be awarded, fully taking into consideration the quality of the competition and no animal deemed unworthy by the Judge shall be awarded a premium. Classes must have 4 entries in order to show.

11. Cross entering is permitted in Hunter, Jumper and Hack Divisions as allowed by E.C. rules.

12. **AN ASTERISK (\*) DENOTES A NON E.C. POINTS CLASS.**

Classes do not count for E.C. Provincial Championship awards, however all other show rules apply.

13. **CANCELLATION: CLASS ENTRY FEES ONLY will be refunded upon receipt of certification of disability from a qualified Veterinarian (stall fees will not be refunded). NO REFUND will be made on cancellations received after the holding of the first class in which the horse is entered.**

14. **ADD/SCRATCHES: Add/Scratches must be made by 5:00 pm the day before the class is scheduled. We would appreciate your co-operation in this regard to enable us to keep the show moving and running smoothly.**

15. **DRESS FOR EXHIBITORS AND ATTENDANTS:** Suit or habit (dress-shirt, tie, & hat). Exhibitors and attendants are not allowed in the ring unless appropriately attired.

**SCHOOLING & EXERCISE RULES:**

**ARTICLE G201 SCHOOLING RULES FOR HUNTER, EQUITATION AND JUMPERS:**

1. All EC-sanctioned competitions must use current FEI schooling rules as listed. Refer to Chapter 9, **FEI Rules Article 244 EXERCISE AND SCHOOLING AREAS AND PRACTICE OBSTACLES**. These rules pertain to all hunter, equitation and jumper classes and divisions at all EC sanctioned competitions.

**16. HEADGEAR (HARD HATS): Rule G102.**

At all EC-sanctioned competitions, all competitors, including foreign competitors, in EC National classes must wear ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened at all times while mounted on the competition grounds.

**Rule G102.2 "Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened."**

**17. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds be selected for equine medication control testing.** The Testing Program will be carried out by the E.C. Manitoba Provincial Drug Committee. Chapter 10 (General Reg.), entitled "Medication Control" in the 2010 Rule Book will govern, and special attention should be given by all exhibitors to reading this Chapter carefully. It will be enforced, including the inspection of personal property. Positive tests will result in prizes being forfeited and a denial of entry to all future Royal Manitoba Winter Fair Horse Show competitions. Exhibitors will be assessed a fee of **\$7.00** per horse/pony entered, which will be forwarded to the Provincial office to provide funds for research, inspection and enforcement regarding use of medication and drugs.

18. Behaviour of exhibitors and associates must be above reproach at all times. Failure to comply may result in ejection from the buildings, forfeiture of entry fees and suspension of exhibiting privileges.

**19. PROTESTS:** All protests must be made out to the RMWF in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 cash or certified cheque as per E.C. Rule Book where applicable for Horse Show. Such protests must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal and must be delivered to the Horse Show Committee within 48 (forty-eight) hours after the occasion for such protest.

**20. PHOTOGRAPHS OF EXHIBITOR(S) AND/OR EXHIBITS:** Each exhibitor shall agree that photographs taken of the exhibitor and/or exhibits by any photographer approved by the RMWF may be used for purposes of promotion by the RMWF or its official sponsors.

**21. LIABILITY:** All exhibits shall be under the control and direction of the RMWF but solely at the risk of the exhibitor. The RMWF will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft of or to any exhibit, irrespective of the cause of such damage, injury, loss or theft, whether such is caused by negligence or not. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, occasioned by or arising from any article\animal exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the RMWF against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.

22. **ALL RIDERS MUST DISMOUNT IN DESIGNATED AREAS.**

23. **ALCOHOL:** Unless a paid authorized bar is in effect consumption of alcoholic beverages in public areas of the RMWF will not be tolerated. Violators of this rule will be dealt with accordingly.

24. **NO SMOKING BY-LAW IN EFFECT.**

25. **DOGS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN ANY AREA OF THE COMPLEX, OTHER THAN THE BARN.**

26. NO SCOOTERS, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, No unauthorized Golf Carts, Gator style, and/or other similar vehicles in the Horse barns at any time. Those wishing to use such vehicles to travel to and from the camper area must park them at their own risk outside the barns.

27. Barns will be available Friday March 26th, 2010. Vacant horse trailers must be parked in the designated area. Warm up times will be posted at the Livestock office and outside hunter ring. The Barn Superintendent will be available with a list of stall locations and allocations, these lists will also be posted in all barns.

**TACK ROOMS: *May we suggest.....***

All tack room curtains be made out of fire retardant material.

No plastic, No cooking in tack rooms.

For safety sake Exhibitors have available a ten (10) pound ABC type fire extinguisher.

28. Hay, straw and shavings will be available for purchase.

INITIAL BEDDING WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.

29. **ALL BARN AND STABLING AREAS MUST BE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.**

30. **All livestock and other exhibits must remain in the barns, or display area until after the show on April 3, 2010** unless special permission is granted to remove said exhibit at an earlier time. All exhibitors failing to abide by this rule will automatically forfeit all or such portion of the prize money as the Executive Committee shall determine in its discretion, and offenders may be barred for one year.

The E.C., the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

The E.C. is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never are subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring those owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

**REGULATIONS GOVERNING ENTRIES TO E.C. RECOGNIZED MEMBER SHOWS FOR 2010: E.C. MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED OF ALL COMPETITORS, TRAINERS, OWNERS, LEASEES & AGENTS EXCEPT:**

A) Members of National Breed Organizations which are affiliated with the Equine Canada have the right to show in their Breed Division Classes at all Recognized E.C. shows, where E.C. membership is a requirement, without becoming an Individual Competitor Member of the E.C. However, they require a temporary sport license.

B) Reg. A208, Exhibitors who are NOT members of the E.C. will be permitted to exhibit at any recognized show/event in any calendar year with the purchase of a TEMPORARY COMPETITORS' SPORT LICENSE and payment of a thirty (\$30.00) fee for that specific show/ event to be collected by the Show Secretary and forwarded to the E.C. National Office along with a copy of the Temporary Membership form. Exhibitors who have not reached their tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) birthday as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year entering walk-trot, lead-line, pet-pony, short stirrup classes only are exempt from E.C. membership. Passports and memberships of the owner of ponies or horses in such classes are not required. This rule also applies to drivers under 10 years of age who compete in pet-pony and pleasure driving ponies where the driver is restricted to less than 10 years of age.

C) Entries limited to classes under National and Canadian Cutting Horse Rules.

D) Entries limited to Canadian Girls' Barrel Racing Events under C.G.R.A. Rules.

E) Exhibitors and equitation riders from other countries who are bona fide members of their own National Equestrian Federations which are members of the Federation Equestre Internationale.

EXCEPTION – E.C. and CET Medal classes.

Entries under A), B), C), D), and E) above will not count towards E.C. Provincial Championship Awards. Also, such equitation riders may not enter E.C. or CET Medal Classes.

**THE RULE BOOK**

Exhibitors, Judges, Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Full details of Horse Show Operations – E.C. (including F.E.I.) Rules. List of recognized Judges – Other vital information is **IN THE RULEBOOK** copyright exclusive use of Recognized Shows. Every individual Senior and Junior Competitor Member receives a copy of the Rule Book and is eligible to count points won at a Recognized E.C. Show for Annual Championship Awards.

**OPEN TO HORSES ONLY**

Horses entered in this Division MUST conform to the type and characteristics of a Road hack animal as defined in the E.C. Rule Book, G1402. Open to horses over 14.2 hands, stallion, mare or gelding. Horses to enter ring at a walk. To be shown at a flat-footed walk with a reasonably loose rein, trot, strong trot, easy canter and hand gallop. Only 8 horses to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on 55% performance, 20% substance, 15% conformation and 10% manners.

2. Senior riders must be amateurs as per G108 and possess a current EC amateur card. Note that amateur cards must be purchased annually.
3. **Fence Heights:**
  - a) **Jumping phase - maximum 1.00m**

4. There will be no water jump in any of the competitions, but a Liverpool is mandatory.
5. Eligibility Requirements:

6. Trainers may walk both the gymnastic course and the jumping course with riders.
7. Course designers must have at least EC Recorded status.
8. Regional Finals will be held to determine a winner for each region.
  - a) There will be three phases; flat phase, gymnastic phase and jumping phase.
  - b) Flat phase will be a simplified version of the CET Medal flat test. (Test may be read.)
  - c) There will be a final phase. The Judge will ask for individual testing of the top four competitors on their own horses. The competitors in the final phase will not switch horses.
  - d) Trainers may walk both the courses with riders.

The class shall have a minimum of two phases, a flat phase and either gymnastic or jumping phase. The flat phase must immediately follow the gymnastic or jumping phase. All riders or a minimum of 12, who completed the course are eligible for the flat phase.

- a) Standing or restrictive martingales are not permitted. NO martingales permitted in flat phase.
- b) Tack and equipment must remain the same for both phases under penalty of elimination. Exception, whips, spurs and martingales.
- c) The class will be judged 60% over fences and 40% on the flat and will be run under jumper rules (Table A, FEI Article 238.1). During flat phase riders will show at a working walk, trot sitting, trot rising and showing a lengthening of stride, working canter and working canter showing a lengthening of stride.

A time allowed will be established based on 350 meters per minute.
